



Presidential Citation for 2010-11 Rotaract Clubs

Rotaract clubs are asked to complete the following questionnaire to test their activities. Clubs that score at least 30 points, out of a possible 50 points, will qualify for the 2010-11 Presidential Citation.

The questionnaire is to be reviewed and signed by the sponsoring Rotary club president to certify the Rotaract club's achievement and then sent to the district governor (not to Rotary International). The completed questionnaire must be received by the district governor no later than 31 March 2011 for the club to be eligible for the Presidential Citation.

The answers to all questions on the questionnaire are subject to The Four-Way Test!

Governors must certify the list of clubs that have earned the citation and send it to RI World Headquarters by no later than 15 April 2011. For more information, see the *2010-11 Presidential Citation*, available for download at www.rotary.org.

- Does your club meet at least twice each month? (5 points)
- Has your club undertaken at least one major project designed to serve the school or community within the past 12 months? (5 points)
- Has your club undertaken at least one major project designed to promote international understanding within the past 12 months? (5 points)
- Has your club arranged for professional development activities that expand the members' understanding of the work environment and business opportunities within the community within the past 12 months? (5 points)
- Has your club provided leadership development activities aimed at making members more effective leaders in their personal lives and teaching them how to develop and sustain strong clubs with relevant projects? (5 points)
- Have your club projects involved the active participation of nearly all the club members within the past 12 months? (5 points)
- Did your club organize at least one successful fundraiser within the past 12 months? (5 points)

- □ Has at least one member of your club registered to attend the Rotaract Preconvention Meeting? (5 points)
- Did your club commemorate World Rotaract Week during the week of 13 March through a joint activity with your sponsoring Rotary club or by promoting the positive effect that Rotaract clubs have on their communities? (5 points)
- Has your club asked individual Rotarians from your sponsoring Rotary club to serve as mentors to each Rotaractor in your club? (5 points)
